Discussion was had concerning the preparation and the amount of the stipend to be paid to Ms. Everlove for the preparation of a new Ten Year Plan. Everlove stated that she would prefer to present a draft of the new Ten Year Plan to the Trustees and then meet to discuss individual issues. Ms. Everlove stated that it would be at least April before she is able to give an estimate as to when the Ten Year Plan draft will be completed. Mr. Ferguson made a motion to authorize Ms. Everlove at a rate of \$40.00 per hour, not to exceed \$3,000.00, to prepare a draft of a new Ten Year Plan, present the draft and address issues at meeting and then provide a final draft to the Trustees. Mr. Walker seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

Ms. Everlove reported that the webpage has been updated to be a little more appealing. She stated that she will be happy to present a small show & tell at the next meeting to show what other Law Libraries are doing around the State. She is also checking on updated CLEs to post to the website.
