ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 84-2

Pursuant to Fl. Stat. §39.032 and Fl. Rules Judicial Administration 2.050 (b)(2), (3), and (4), the Circuit and County Judges in the counties comprising the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida are designated to hold juvenile detention hearings in all of the counties of the circuit.

2. The County Court in each county is designated and the County Judges of that Court are assigned to hold such hearings Monday through Friday of each week.

3. The Circuit and County Judges residing in St. Lucie County are assigned to conduct such hearings for all of the cases arising in any county of the Circuit on Saturday and/or Sunday of each week on a rotating basis.

4. By agreement any Circuit or County Judge may assist or substitute for the Judges of St. Lucie County at any time.

5. The Order of the Acting Chief Judge dated July 2, 1981, "Designation and Assignment of Judges for Juvenile Detention Hearings," and the Order of the Acting Chief Judge dated July 8, 1981, re assignment of Judge David Harper to conduct juvenile detention hearings, are hereby revoked.
