ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 84-3

The assignment of Judges to appeals from the County Courts shall be as follows:

- (1) Appeals from County Court criminal cases shall be to the Circuit Judge or Judges assigned to Criminal Felony cases.
- (2) Appeals from County Court civil cases shall be assigned to the Circuit Judge or Judges assigned to Circuit Civil cases.
- (3) Appeals from County Court Civil Infractions shall be assigned to the Circuit Judge or Judges assigned to Circuit Felony cases.
- (4) Habeas Corpus cases involving prisoners under criminal charges shall be assigned to the Circuit Judge or Judges assigned to Circuit Felony cases.
- (5) Habeas Corpus cases not covered by Paragraph (4) shall be assigned to the Circuit Judges or Judges assigned to the Circuit Civil cases. In counties in which domestic cases in general are assigned to a specific Circuit Judge or Judges, he or they shall be assigned Habeas Corpus cases involving custody of minors arising out of the separation of parents or pending adoptions.
- (6) The undersigned's letter to Clerks dated September 15, 1978, is rescinded.
