2ND. AMENDMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 91-2

WHEREAS it has been brought to my attention as Chief Judge that Administrative Order 91-2 needs to be amended to allow the Chief Judge to appoint the Appellate Panel Members and to modify the length of service on the Appellate Panel, **IT IS THEREFORE:**

ORDERED:

1) Paragraph 1 is amended to read "An Administrative Judge for Appeals (hereinafter called Administrative Judge) and the three other Circuit Judge members of the Appellate Panel shall be appointed annually by the Chief Judge of the Circuit and their term of service shall be for one year unless changed by Administrative Order."

2) Paragraph 5(a) is amended to read "He shall prepare (Preferably prior to the beginning of the year) a schedule of 12 month Appellate Panel meetings. "The rest of paragraph 5(a) is vacated.
