WHEREAS, it has become necessary to evacuate the Martin County Courthouse due to environmental problems, and


WHEREAS, It is necessary that the business of the Courts within Martin County not be unduly disrupted, it is therefore, pursuant to Rule 2.050, Rules of Judicial Administration,

ORDERED that:

Effective September 13, 1993, until further order, temporary court facilities for Martin County will be located at the Martin County Temporary Judicial Center, 800 South East Monterey Road, Stuart, Florida with the exception of some County Court and all Juvenile Court continuing at their present locations until the remaining two courtrooms are deemed ready for occupation.

Administrative Order 75-2 concerning electronic recording is reinstated for Martin County.
