SPECIAL AMENDMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 92-01
ALLOWING EMERGENCY RELIEF TO MARTIN COUNTY

This Court, having been advised by the judges of Martin County that due to the evacuation of the Martin County Courthouse it will be necessary to give temporary relief from Administrative Order 92-01 in that Domestic Violence and Injunctions for Protection and First Appearance Hearings are no longer available at the Martin County Courthouse, and pursuant to Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is therefore:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

First Appearance Hearings shall be held at the Martin County Jail until video first appearances can be established at the Martin County Administration Building.

The Martin County Sheriffs Office will supply a security officer at the temporary Martin County Clerks office to page the On-Call Clerk when a victim is in need of assistance. The On-Call Clerk will then notify the judge doing first appearance hearings that the Injunction for Protection needs to be reviewed and signed (if sufficient).

This Order will remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
