ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 92-15
EMERGENCY ORDER PRIORITIZING COURTROOM USAGE

WHEREAS, it has been necessary to evacuate the Martin County Courthouse, and

WHEREAS, there is currently a shortage of available short-term temporary Courtrooms, pursuant to Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Procedure, it is therefore:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that effective December 28, 1992, until more permanent Courtroom space can be provided by Martin County, usage of the short-term temporary Courtrooms are to be assigned by the Court Administrators Office using the following prioritized list:

1. Circuit Felony
2. County Misdemeanor and Criminal Traffic
3. County Non-Criminal Traffic
4. Circuit Juvenile
5. Domestic Relations Injunctions and Temporary Relief
6. Competency and Emergency Guardianship
7. Circuit Civil
8. County Civil
9. Probate

This Order will remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
