ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 92-04

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Martin County, Florida, has entered into a contract to clean the air conditioning system within the Martin County Courthouse and have notified the Judges serving Martin County that work will begin March 21, 1992, and

WHEREAS, all the Circuit and County Court Judges with offices in Martin County have expressed to the Martin County Commission their concerns about the exposure of court personnel, jurors and the general public, to the potential hazards associated with remaining in the Courthouse during the cleaning procedure, and

WHEREAS, no provision has been made by the County Commission of Martin County for alternative court facilities, although the facilities were requested by the Judges serving Martin County, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the business of the courts within Martin County not be unduly disrupted, it is therefore, pursuant to Rule 2.050, Rules of Judicial Administration,


ORDERED that:

1. Effective March 21, 1992, through April 3, 1992, temporary court facilities for Martin County will be located as follows:

a. Circuit Courts are to be located at the Martin County School Board, 500 East Ocean Boulevard, Stuart, Florida, and the Martin County Jail, Monterrey Road, Stuart, Florida.

b. County Courts are to be located at the Stuart City Hall, 121 S. W. Flagler, Stuart, Florida.
