IN RE: ASSIGNMENT COVERAGE

Pursuant to Rule 2.050 (b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, all Judges shall inform the Chief Judge of any planned absences from their office.

Therefore it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:


1). Each Judge shall make arrangements to have his assignment covered during his absence, and shall advise the Court Administrator's Office of the arrangements.

2). In an instance where the Judge will be absent from his assignment for more than two (2) days, the Judge shall inform the Chief Judge, in addition to the Court Administrator's Office.

3). The notice shall be submitted in writing to the Chief Judge, with a copy provided to the Court Administrator's Office, and shall include the arrangements the Judge has made to cover his assignment or emergency matters during his absence.

4). This procedure shall be followed in all instances, whether the Judge is absent for vacation purposes, attendance at a Judge's Conference, or any other matter requiring his absence.
