ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 93-05

IN RE: RECORDING OF COURT PROCEEDINGS IN CAPITAL CASES OF
MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE OR OF A CAPITAL FELONY UNDER
FLORIDA STATUTE 789.161 (DESTRUCTIVE DEVICES)

Pursuant to 2.070(c)(1), Rules of Judicial Administration, as Chief Judge I deem it
appropriate to order:

Use of court reporters in the above-styled cases shall be a back-up to the electronic or
video recordings, which are the primary source of the official court record. In indigency
cases, court reporters shall be limited to the plea, trial, and sentencing phases of these
proceedings.

Transcripts for all phases of these cases shall be prepared with the use of the
electronic or video recording, with the court reporters as a back-up only when the transcriber
reports a transcription problem to the Court Administrator .
