IN RE:        CLARIFICATION OF COURTHOUSE SECURITY EXEMPTION POLICY


After consultation with some of the Sheriffs and pursuant to Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.050. The following courthouse security measures are therefore ordered:

The Sheriff of each County of the Circuit shall have a policy of either no exemptions as to passing through the Security System or establish a list of persons and/or agency personnel who may be waived from the security requirements.

A no exemption policy shall not pertain to Judges, Judicial Assistants, and staff of the Court Administrator's office.

This is a further clarification of the exemption policy stated in Administrative Order 89-4 and further outlined: Annex A, B, C, and D.
