A D M I N I S T R A T I V E O R D E R 94-9

RE: COST OF SUPERVISION RATE

WHEREAS Florida Statute 948.09 which state in part, "any person ordered by the court to be placed on probation, drug offender probation or community control must, as a condition of any placement pay the Department the court ordered amount.

WHEREAS the statute establishes a rate of not less that \$40.00 per month for a person placed on misdemeanor probation by a county court, it is hereby:

ORDERED that pursuant to that statute and Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration:

1) Cases placed on probation, drug offender probation or community control under the supervision of the Florida Department of Correction shall be assessed a Cost of Supervision rate of \$40.00 monthly as a standard condition.


2) The sentencing judge may order a different rate which cannot exceed the per diem cost of the supervision on a case by case basis as circumstances justify.

3) The Florida Department of Corrections shall exempt persons from payment of the monthly rate for those months in which the following conditions exist:

- a) The person is a recipient of Aid for Dependent Children or Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

- b) The person supports minors who are his/her legal dependents and income falls below poverty guidelines.
- c) The person is a minor and their legal guardian(s) or parent(s) are recipients of Aid for Dependent Children or Supplemental Security Income or the household income falls below poverty guidelines.

4) This Administrative Order shall take effect December 1, 1994.
