
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 95 - 8

RE: Pending Caseload Reports

Whereas the Chief Judge of each Judicial Circuit, is responsible for the timely and efficient disposition of cases, and as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Procedure, it is therefore ORDERED:

Effective January 1, 1996, the Clerk of the Court in each county of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit shall provide a monthly pending caseload report to each judge in that county assigned to the Felony, Civil, Probate, Guardianship, and Family Law Divisions (including Juvenile). This pending caseload report shall include the case number, style, the date the case was opened, and the number of days that have elapsed since the case was opened. The Clerk shall also furnish a copy of each report to the Court Administrator's Office for review by the Chief Judge and the Court Administrator.
