ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 96 - 3

RE: First Appearance Hearings in Okeechobee County  
on Weekends and Holidays

Whereas Okeechobee County Judge Edward A. Miller intends to resign effective July 1, 1996, and it is necessary to provide first appearance hearings on weekends and holidays, and as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Procedure, it is therefore ORDERED:

1. All Judges of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit shall be placed on an alphabetical rotation list to provide first appearance hearings in Okeechobee County for weekends and holidays until a new County Judge takes office.
2. If a Judge assigned for specific date(s) cannot cover the assigned date, the assigned Judge shall make the necessary arrangements for coverage with another Judge.
3. The Court Administrator's Office shall prepare the rotation list and attach it to this Order.
