ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 96 - 6

RE: Transfer of Circuit and County Court Mediation Trust Funds to Nineteenth
Judicial Circuit Mediation Program Fund


As per paragraph 5 of Administrative Order 94-7, it is necessary for funds to be transferred to continue the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Mediation Program, therefore as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Procedure and pursuant to Local Orders concerning distribution of the Mediation Trust Fund monies, the following is **ORDERED**:

1. Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee, and St. Lucie Counties shall calculate the net amount of funds on hand within the Civil/Family Mediation Trust Fund and the Small Claims Mediation Trust Funds within their counties as of August 1, 1996, and shall remit by September 1, 1996, fifty percent (50%) of the net amount to St. Lucie County, C/O Management and Budget Office for placement in the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit Mediation Program budget coded as follows:

COAS: B
PRED FUND: 183TOT Ct. Administrator
FUND: 183 Ct. Admininstrator-19th Judicial Circuit
ORG: 1637 Arbitration/Mediation

2. Each county shall notify the Chief Judge with a copy to the Court Administrator of the amount of money transferred and the St. Lucie County Budget Office shall notify the Court Administrator of the total amount in the program fund as of September 1, 1996.
