ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 96-9

RE: First Appearance Hearings in Okeechobee County

Whereas, there is no resident Circuit Judge and no resident County Judge available for First Appearance Hearings, and as Acting Chief Judge, pursuant to Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is therefore Ordered:

Circuit Judge Dwight L. Geiger is assigned to First Appearance Hearings daily except when another Judge (Circuit or County) is filling in for either the vacant county judgeship or Circuit Judge L.B. Vocelle.

This Order will not affect the already established weekend rotation for Okeechobee County and will remain in effect until the new County Judge assumes office.
