ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 97-01

RE: Obtaining the Services of Court Reporters in Capital Cases In Which the State Is Seeking the
Death Penalty

As Chief Judge pursuant to Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.050, the following
procedure shall be ORDERED in obtaining court reporters for the above-styled cases in which the
defendant is indigent:

1. The Court Administrator's Office shall obtain a list of court reporting firms willing to
provide court reporting services in the above-styled cases at the rates established by
Administrative order 92-5, any future Administrative Orders and standard set forth in
section 25.383, Florida Statute (1995)
2. The presiding judge shall notify the Court Administrator's Office that a court reporter
is needed in order to comply with Second Amended Administrative Order 93-5. The
Court Administration Office shall then assign court reporting firms on a rotation basis
to assure equity in assignments.
