
RE: APPROVAL OF COMMERCIAL DELIVERY  
SERVICES PURSUANT TO 731.301 (1) (a),  
FLORIDA STATUTES (1993)

WHEREAS 731.301(1) (a), Fla. Stat., as amended by Ch. 93-257, Laws of Florida, provides an additional method for service of a petition when formal notice of a Petition or other proceeding is required under the Probate Code, to wit, the petition shall be served "by any form of mail or by any commercial delivery service approved by the Chief Judge of each judicial Circuit, requiring a signed receipt";

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority set forth in 731.301(1) (a), Fla. Stat. (1993), I, PAUL B. KANAREK, as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, hereby approved the following commercial delivery services requiring a signed receipt as methods by which formal notice, pursuant to 731.301(1)(a), Fla. Stat. (1993) may be affected, to wit:

1. DHL Worldwide Express
2. United Parcel Services
3. Federal Express
4. Airborne Express
5. Any other commercial delivery services which may be added to this approved list upon proper application.
