
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 97-02

RE: Notification to State Attorney and Public Defender of Results of Indigence Investigation

Whereas, the Florida Legislature funded an Indigence Examiner for each Judicial Circuit to insure that criminal defendants obtaining the services of the Public Defender meet the statutory requirements for obtaining such service, and whereas, it is necessary to report cases whereby the defendant may not statutorily qualify to the appropriate parties, and as Chief Judge, pursuant to Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.050, the following procedures are therefore ORDERED:

1. In all cases in which the Indigence Examiner determines the applicant may not meet the statutory qualifications, the Examiner shall file the original report with the Clerk of the Court in the county whereby the case originated with copies to the State Attorney and Public Defender
2. The State Attorney and Public Defender shall review the report and take the necessary action they deem appropriate.
