**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 97-3**

RE: Implementation of Rule 2.065 -- Rules of Judicial Administration  
NOTICES TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Pursuant to the attached Supreme Court Order of December 23, 1996, and as Chief Judge pursuant to Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, the following implementation procedures are Ordered:

1. Each Clerk of Court, State Attorney Office, Public Defender Office, and law enforcement agency shall name an Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator.
2. The following language approved by Rule 2.065 shall be included in all notices of court proceedings to be held in a public facility, and all process compelling such proceedings which are prepared or provided upon demand, effective January 1, 1997:


**NOTICE TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES**

All notices of court proceedings to be held in a public facility, and all process compelling appearance at such proceedings, shall include the following:

"If you are a person with a disability who needs any accommodation in order to participate in this proceeding, you are entitled, at no cost to you, to the provision of certain assistance. Please contact [identify applicable court personnel by name, address, and telephone number] within 2 working days of your receipt of this [describe notice]; if you are hearing or voice impaired, call 1-800-955-8771."

3. Clerks, State Attorney Offices, and Public Defender Offices may continue to use the current supply of forms that have the former Americans with Disabilities notice which were printed prior to December 23, 1996, until September 30, 1997.
4. Administrative Order 93-01 and Amended Administrative Order 93-01 are hereby VOID.
