ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 98-10

RE: Certification of Parent Education and Family Stabilization Classes

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 61.21(3), Florida Statutes (1998), all parties to a dissolution of marriage action with minor children or a paternity action which involves issues of parental responsibility are required to complete a Parent Education and Family Stabilization class, unless excused by the court, and,

WHEREAS, Section 61.21(2)(a), Florida Statutes (1998), requires all judicial circuits to approve these parenting courses, and,

WHEREAS, in Administrative Order 98-08, this court has established certain basic course requirements and a procedure to obtain court approval for such a course;

NOW THEREFORE, I, PAUL B. KANAREK, as Chief Judge, pursuant to the authority vested in me under Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, do hereby approve the following Parent Education and Family Stabilization courses to be provided in each county of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit;
