ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 98-13

RE: Creation of Court Technology Committee

WHEREAS the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit is in the process of increasing and expanding the informational technology available to judges and court personnel through the utilization of personal computers, electronic mail, the Internet, and other creative and innovative means and,

WHEREAS there is a need for uniform policies and procedures that will promote the efficient and responsible use of these new technologies as they come on-line and made available,

NOW THEREFORE, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. There is hereby established the Nineteenth Circuit Court Technology Committee to be composed of the Chief Judge, the Court Administrator, at least one Circuit Judge and one County Judge, the Court's Technology Officer, and any other persons the Chief Judge may hereafter elect to appoint. The Chief Judge shall serve as the chair and preside over and conduct the business of the Court Technology Committee.

2. The Court Technology Committee will meet regularly as determined by the Chief Judge to draft and prepare policies, practices, and procedures relating to technology issues confronting the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.
