ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 98- 14

RE: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DUTY JUDGE

WHEREAS it has been brought to the Courts Attention that paragraph 2 of Administrative Order 98- 14 needs to be amended and as Chief Judge pursuant to FL Rules of Judicial Administration 2.050, it is therefore Ordered:

1. Paragraph 2 is amended to read: The Duty Judge shall serve for a one week period beginning Monday at **5:00 P.M.** to the following Monday at **5:00 P.M.** On Holiday and weekends the Duty Judge shall be available 24 hours per day, except during the times that the courthouse in each of the counties is open and clerks are available to file petitions for ex-parte injunctive relief in domestic violence cases.

2. All other portions of the Administrative Order are unchanged
