ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 98-04

RE: COLLECTION OF TEEN COURT COSTS

WHEREAS, The 1998 Florida Legislature corrected the conflict existing between Florida Statute 39.019 and 318.18 thus allowing the assessing and collecting of \$3.00 for the Teen Court Trust Fund in civil traffic cases, and

WHEREAS, each local ordinance gives the Chief Judge authority over the trust fund, therefore as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administrative 2.050,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Section (1) of Administrative Order 97-5 is hereby **REVOKED**.
2. Each Clerk of Court for each of the counties in this circuit, is ordered to begin assessing and collecting \$3.00 for the Teen Court Trust Fund effective June 1, 1998.
