FIRST AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 99 - 13

IN RE: Opening Sealed Files to Microfilm

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Martin County is currently in the process of microfilming the court files for storage, and;

WHEREAS, a number of court files or portions of court files have been sealed pursuant to court order and it is necessary for the Clerk to microfilm the entire file including the sealed portion;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Martin County is hereby authorized to unseal any sealed court files or portions thereof for the purpose of microfilming these records. The original file or portion of the file that was sealed and the microfilm copy thereof shall be resealed and a copy of this Administrative Order shall be placed both with the original file and the microfilm copy. If the Clerk intends to immediately destroy the original files after they are microfilmed then it will not be necessary for her to reseat those files.
