**RE: FUNDING OF MEDIATOR COORDINATOR AND DEPENDENCY MEDIATION
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the budgeted funds available for the above-name Programs will be depleted concurrent with the end of the Counties fiscal year 98-99 and whereas it is essential to the operation of the court system to continue these programs, therefore as Chief Judge pursuant to Florida Rules of Judicial Administration 2.050 the following transfer of funds is ordered:

(1) The Clerks of the Court for Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee and St. Lucie Counties shall forward by September 15, 1999, to the Clerk of St. Lucie County the following amounts from the Mediation Trust Funds in their respective Counties:
