**RE: APPOINTMENT OF CIVIL INFRACTION HEARING OFFICER
WILLIAM L. HENDRY FOR ST. LUCIE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, on October 5, 1999, Chief Justice Major Harding, pursuant to Rule 6.630, Florida Rules of Traffic Court authorized St. Lucie County of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit to utilize Civil Traffic Infraction Hearing Officer; and

WHEREAS, the interests of the public, litigants, and the judiciary require a flexible and speedy system of the civil traffic infractions; and as Chief Judge pursuant to Rule 6.630(c), Florida Rules of Traffic Court, it is therefore:

ORDERED, that William L. Hendry, a member in good standing of the Florida Bar, is hereby appointed as the Civil Traffic Infraction Hearing Officer for St. Lucie County of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.
