ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 00-12

IN RE: **Teen Court Grants - Martin County**


WHEREAS Teen Court has been established in the Nineteenth Circuit and whereas numerous schools have agreed to participate in Teen Court and whereas costs are incurred by participating schools and whereas each County of the Circuit has established a Teen Court Trust Fund,

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority as Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, it is ordered that the Clerk of Court in and for Martin County shall withdraw from the Martin County Teen Court Trust Fund the following amount made payable to the school listed below:

Martin County High School has submitted a Teen Court Budget to the Chief Judge and has agreed to account how the monies were expended at the end of the 2000-2001 school year.
