Whereas on November 16, 1994, Chief Justice Stephen Grimes, pursuant to Rule 1.491(b), Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, issued an Administrative Order authorizing the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit to utilize Child Support Hearing Officers in both Title IV-D and Non-Title IV-D proceedings; and

Whereas on February 27, 1998, Chief Justice Gerald Kogan, pursuant to Rule 12.491, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure, issued an Administrative order authoring the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit to utilize Child Support Hearing Officers in both Title IV-D and non-IV-D proceedings (this order superseded the order of November 16, 1994); and

Whereas the interests of the public, litigants, and the judiciary require a flexible and speedy system of the resolution of proceedings involving the establishment, modification, and enforcement of child support; it is therefore;

ORDERED that Patricia I. Taylor, a member in good standing with the Florida Bar, is hereby appointed as a Support Enforcement Hearing Officer for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit with all powers authorized by Rule 12.491, Family Law Rules of Procedure. This order shall be effective September 22, 2000 and shall supersede all prior orders entered in this regard.
