**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2000-014**

**RE: APPOINTMENT OF CIVIL INFRACTION HEARING OFFICER

**WHEREAS**, on October 5, 1999, Chief Justice Major Harding, pursuant to Rule 6.630, Florida Rules of Traffic Court authorized St. Lucie County of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit to utilize Civil Traffic Infraction Hearing Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the interests of the public, litigants, and the judiciary require a flexible and speedy system of the civil traffic infractions; and as Chief Judge pursuant to Rule 6.630(c), Florida Rules of Traffic Court, it is therefore,

**ORDERED**, that Albert B. Moore, a member in good standing of the Florida Bar, is hereby appointed as the Civil Traffic Infraction Hearing Officer for St. Lucie County of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit.
