
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 00- 02

RE: ASSIGNMENT OF OKEECHOBEE COUNTY COURT RECUSALS
TO CIRCUIT JUDGE BURTON C. CONNER.

Whereas the County Court Judge of Okeechobee Court occasionally has to recuse from certain county court cases and whereas due to geographical distances it is inefficient to assign these cases to a judge in a coastal county of the this circuit, and as Chief Judge of the 19th Circuit, pursuant to Rule 2.050 Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is therefore Ordered:

EFFECTIVE the date of this order All recusals by the County Judge of Okeechobee County are to be reassigned by the Clerk of Court of Okeechobee County to the Circuit Judge assigned to Okeechobee County unless otherwise directed by this court.
