ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 00-03

Whereas the Nineteenth Circuits Teen Court Coordinator position was upgraded to Teen Court Director and whereas the budget for Teen Court had to be adjusted accordingly and as Chief Judge pursuant to Fla. Rules of Judicial Adm. 2.050, it is therefore Ordered:

Based on each counties percentage of the total population of the Circuit:


(1) The Clerk of the Court of St. Lucie County shall withdraw \$5,796 from the Teen Court Trust Fund of St. Lucie County and deposit the money in the Teen Court Budget, ORG 689 - Fund 183004-512000 (salaries).

(2) The Clerk of the Court of Indian River County shall withdraw \$3,360 from the Teen Court Trust Fund of Indian River County and forward the money to the Clerk of the Court of St. Lucie County for deposit in the Teen Court Budget, ORG 689 - Fund 183004-512000 (salaries).

(3) The Clerk of the Court of Martin County shall withdraw \$3,738 from the Teen Court Trust Fund of Martin County and forward the money to the Clerk of the Court of St. Lucie County for deposit in the Teen Court Budget, ORG 689 - Fund 183004-512000 (salaries).

(4) The Clerk of the Court of Okeechobee County shall withdraw \$1,106 from the Teen Court Trust Fund of Okeechobee County and forward the money to the Clerk of the Court of St. Lucie County for deposit in the Teen Court Budget, ORG 689 - Fund 183004-512000 (salaries).
