**IN RE:        Teen Court Budget**

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority as Acting Chief Judge of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, it is ordered that to fund Teen Court for county fiscal year FY2000-2001, each Clerk of the Court in our Circuit is to withdraw the amounts listed below based on the counties population percentage of the total circuit population, and forward that amount to the Clerk of St. Lucie County for placement in the Teen Court Budget:
