**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2001-06**

**RE: Drug Court**

**WHEREAS**, there have been some delays in getting Drug Court cases timely set on the Drug Court calendar, and;

**WHEREAS**, by immediately reassigning case to the Drug Court docket upon the filing of an information; written agreement of the parties; or referral by the presiding judge, cases will be brought to court at an earlier time, it is therefore;

**ORDERED** that upon the filing of an Information stamped "**DRUG COURT**"; the written stipulation of the parties to refer the case to Drug Court; or upon the presiding judge referring the case to Drug Court in open court, the case shall immediately be removed from its current docket and the Clerk shall schedule the case for Arraignment at the next available Drug Court date that is at least 15 days from the date of filing or referral. The Clerk shall thereafter send a Notice to the parties showing the new Arraignment date. All cases placed on the Drug Court docket shall remain on that docket unless they are moved pursuant to an order entered by the Drug Court judge.
